In this email, you let folks know WiTWA [+] 2020 Conference is finally happening and this is the chance for them to be part of conversations that matter regarding careers in tech [+]. Share the event link (https://witwa-2020.heysummit.com/) to check it out.
- Week of Monday 9 November 2020 (Two weeks after the event): 3rd email The event was fabulous! Share your highlights, perhaps a behind-the-scenes shot of your involvement.
